ARCHDIOCESE KINGSTON

Dear Reverend Monsignor/Father,

In order to bring about a sense of order and secure feelings for congregants in the Archdiocese of Kingston, I would like to appeal to your common-sense and offer a few directives around the practices of Holy Communion and church attendance in general, due to the awareness of the COVID-19 virus.

As of 10 March 2020, the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC) has assessed the public health risk associated with COVID-19 as low for Canada. Public health risk is continually reassessed as new information becomes available.

Handwashing – The most effective means to prevent the spread of germs and viruses is frequent and complete handwashing (20 seconds). Parishes may want to make available alcohol-based hand sanitizers at the entrance of Churches, Halls, Parish Offices, and in the sacristy. Ideally, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion should purify their hands before they come to the sanctuary.

Sign of Peace – The Sign of Peace is not to be omitted from the celebration of the Eucharist. However, shaking hands is not necessary. Instead, kindly direct people to offer the Sign of Peace by a reverent bow and a simple "Peace be with you,"

Reception of Holy Communion – Holy Communion offered under both Species is a fuller sign of our faith in the Lord's Eucharistic Presence. Given that there is no guarantee that the communicant's hands are germ-free, people remain free to receive Holy Communion either on the tongue or in the hand. At the present time in the Archdiocese there is no need to discontinue receiving Holy Communion under both Species. People who are sick with a cold or flu, or other ailments, should refrain from receiving from the Chalice.

In the event, that the PHAC advises a public health risk is at hand for Ontario, then further communication regarding the reception of Holy Communion may become necessary.

For those who bring Holy Communion to the sick and elderly in Health Care Institutions, please follow the directions of the Institution you are visiting, while being mindful that extra care to wash hands regularly will help to prevent the spread of germs.

Also, people should be reminded that, as always, if they are sick, they should not be coming to Holy Mass or other events.

Please continue to pray for those who have been affected by the coronavirus, for their families and caregivers, as well as those who struggle with fear and anxiety.




