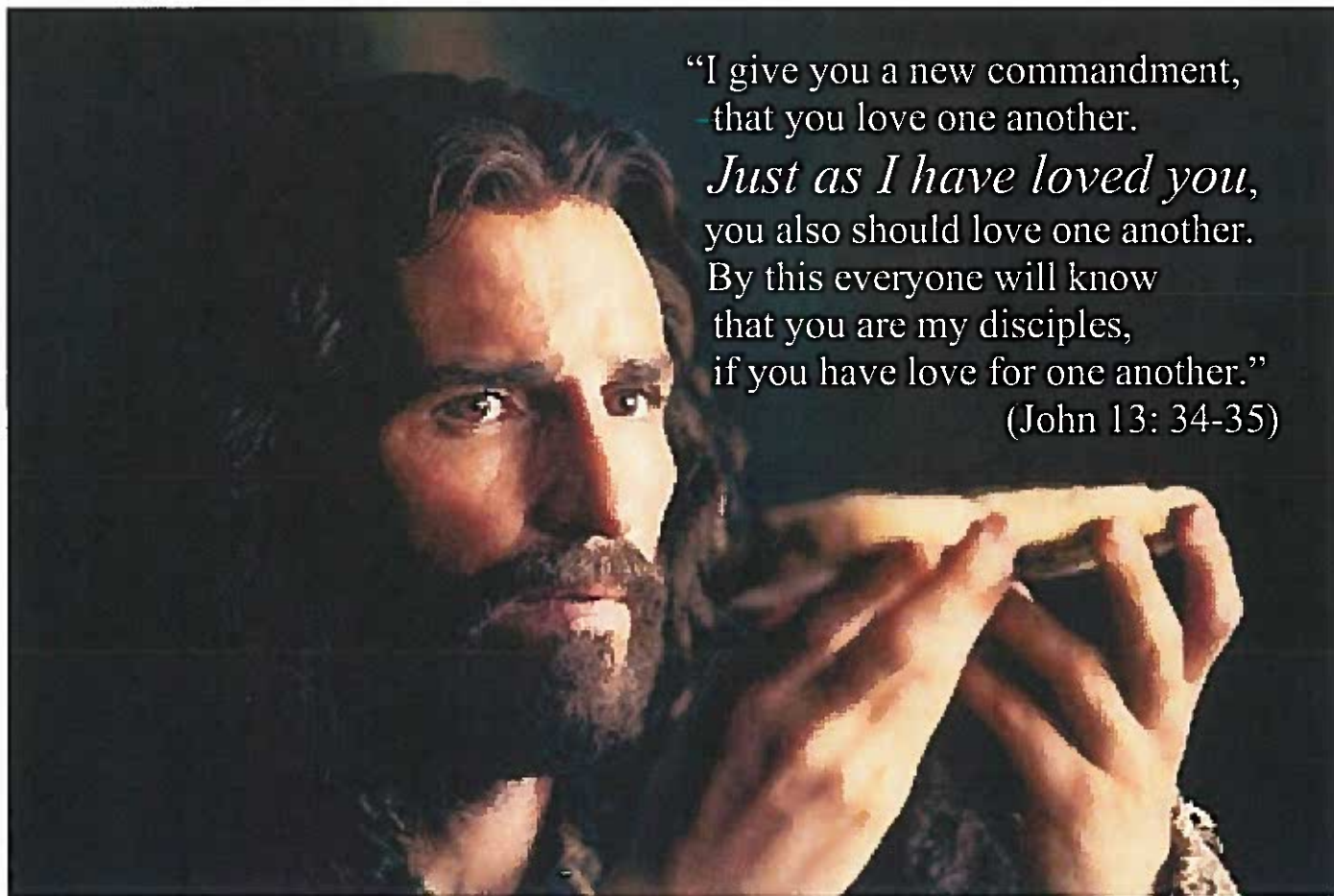

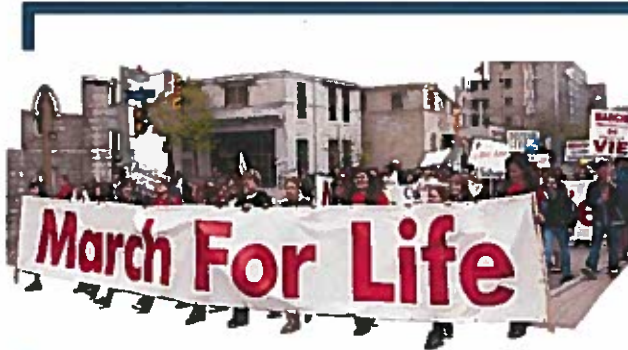

This year's National March For Life will take place at noon on Thursday, May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016 on Parliament Hill, Ottawa, Canada. Join pro-life people from across Canada as we pay respect and draw

attention to the millions of Canadians killed by abortion since 1969.

Almost 40 years ago on May 14, 1969 an omnibus bill was passed in Canadian Parliament which legalized abortion. Today, an unborn baby can be killed for any reason, at any time, up until the moment of birth. The scientific fact that human life begins at conception is ignored by politicians. The humanity of unborn babies is unjustly denied.

The fight to end abortion is a civil rights movement every bit as important as that of Martin Luther King's to end slavery. The killing of innocent human beings via abortion is the human rights issue of our day. For 12 consecutive years, *Campaign Life Coalition* has organized the flagship event of the Canadian civil rights movement which demands the legal right to life for all unborn children from the moment of conception. 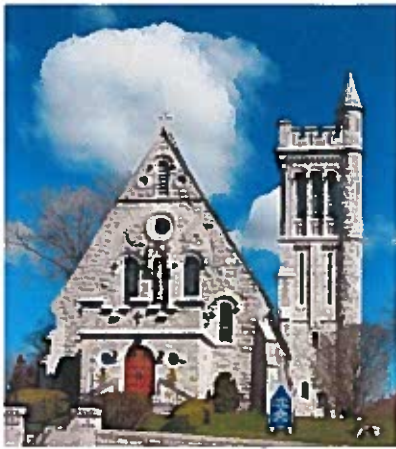

### **The Future of the Church of the Good Thief.**

An information meeting will be held at 7 pm on Thursday May 12, 2016 in Good Thief church. Services were suspended at the church in November 2013. A committee has been working since that time to study the feasibility of repurposing the church so that it can continue to serve the Archdiocese of Kingston, Kingston and Portsmouth. A proposal is being developed to assess the possibility of creating a Catholic Heritage Centre within the church building to serve as the archive of the Archdiocese of Kingston and related Catholic organisations. The steps towards this objective will be outlined at this informal meeting. Please join us.

### **TO THE PARENTS OF OUR YOUNG CHILDREN, MAY WE SUGGEST.....**

Relax! God put the wiggle in children; don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. Of course children need to be taught how to be at Mass and they will learn that from you and those around them. All are welcome! I would far rather hear them here at Mass than to not hear them at all. Please don't be too self-conscious.

You will notice that several young families sit toward the front. I applaud that!! It is easier for your little ones to see and hear what's going on at the altar. They tire of seeing the backs of other's heads. And if you have to take them out, you have to take them. The children are as much a part of the family as anyone else. We were all young once.

Up front they can see and you can quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the priest, altar servers, choir, etc.

Sing the hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behaviour by copying you. As they are growing into how to be at Mass and you have to leave Mass with your child to let them run around outside for a brief time-out please feel free to do so, but, after they have expended that energy, and are ready to settle a bit again, please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me". Sometimes your little one is inconsolable and needs to spend some time at the back with you. I am always so edified to see a father/mother, with his/her child in their arms, on their knees at the back during the Eucharistic prayer. Your little ones need to learn how to be at Mass from you: still at some times, quiet at others, singing out loudly at others.



Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship.

### **TO THE MEMBERS OF OUR PARISH**

The presence of children is a gift to the Church and they are a reminder that families and our parish here at St. Mary's is growing. Children will be a distraction from time to time. Probably your own were from time to time. Please be patient with our little ones. Feel free to assist their parents. Over time as you have gotten to know them feel free to nab a little one who has escaped into the aisle away from their mother or father's care. Their mother or father, I'm sure, will deeply appreciate your help in assisting their son/daughter into becoming a prayerful participant at Mass.

Please welcome our children and give a smile of encouragement to their parents. If they sit near you regularly find out the little one's name and their parents' names. Call them by name when you see them. You can be a big help in the little one's growing into a prayerful participant at Mass.

Above all let us be truly considerate of others..... small and big..... young and elderly!!!!

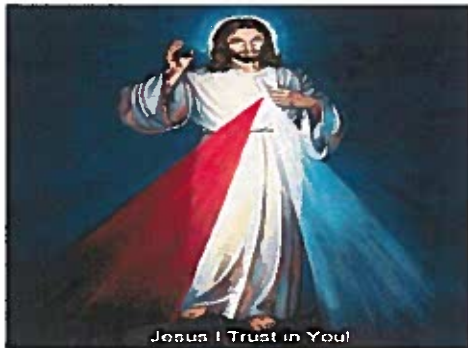
