

# ALPHA AT ST. MARY'S CATHEDRAL



As Father Shawn mentioned in his homily last weekend we will be beginning the ALPHA course in September.

Objective:

The mission of the Church is summed up in the great commission: "Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations; baptize them in the name of the Father and of the

Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you. And look, I am with you always; yes to the end of time."

Mt 28:19-20

Since the Second Vatican Council, the Church has been calling all Catholics to rediscover what it means to engage in these words of Jesus in the world of our time. Pope Paul VI said in Evangelii Nuntiandi: 'Evangelizing is in fact the grace and vocation proper to the Church, her deepest identity. She exists in order to evangelize......". Pope Benedict XVI said, 'The Church is at the service of another; she serves not for herself, not to be a strong body, rather she serves to make the proclamation of Jesus Christ accessible, the great truths and the great forces of love, reconciling love that always comes from the presence of Jesus Christ.'

# Overview:

Alpha is a program based on welcome, hospitality, sharing and prayer that is being used by thousands of parishes in over 70 countries around the world to enable people to experience a personal relationship with Jesus. Alpha consists of a series of ten interactive sessions and one weekend that explore the basics of our faith. Each session includes a meal, a DVD presentation and small group discussion. The presentations are based on the teaching of the Church and Scripture, with different topics explored each week. Topics vary from 'Who is Jesus?' to 'How can I be filled with the Holy Spirit?' to 'How can I make the most of the rest of my life?' The small groups, facilitated by trained leaders, provide the opportunity to build trust and friendship, inviting participants to share openly and honestly, without any criticism or judgment.

With Alpha, 23 million people have been through an experience that touches not only the mind but also the heart and the will. It introduces people to the first proclamation of the good news of Jesus Christ, otherwise known as the kerygma: 'Jesus Christ loves you; he gave his life to save you, and now he is living at your side to enlighten, strengthen and free you.' (Evangelii Gaudium, 164). Alpha invites people to respond to the good news through a decision to follow Jesus. Parishes around the world have seen significant growth in numbers and a new enthusiasm for mission. New members of the parish, having come to faith during Alpha, frequently join parish activities and bring the freshness and joy of their encounter with Christ into the life of the parish.


