Are You or Someone You Know thinking of becoming a Catholic or interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith?

Consider joining The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). RCIA is a Christian Initiation Process for Adults who a) have never been baptized, b) are Christians baptized in another Faith Tradition seeking now to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church, and c) for Catholics who are baptised, but who have not received either their first Holy Communion and/or the Sacrament of Confirmation and who now wish to complete their Christian initiation.

RCIA is a process of education and formation into the life, worship and mission of disciples of Jesus Christ in the Catholic Church. We gather one evening a week from 7 to 9 pm beginning in September, continuing and including the great celebration of the Great Easter Vigil and the reception of candidates into the Catholic Faith, and concludes a few weeks later after a period of postbaptismal catechesis. Attention all Judges, lawyers, and all who work in the Justice system. On Thursday, September 22, 2016, Archbishop O'Brien will be celebrating the Red Mass at 7 pm in St Mary's Cathedral (Johnson St at Clergy) with a wine and cheese reception to follow in St. Mary's Parish Centre. The Red Mass, which is dedicated particularly to those in the legal profession (lawyers, judges, clerks, court reporters, court security officers, legal assistants, receptionists, and students and professors of the Faculty of Law), derives its name from the colour of the vestments worn by the celebrant to symbolize the tongues of fire of the Holy Spirit and martyrdom and is generally celebrated contemporaneously with the opening of the courts, which commences the judicial year. The tradition of the Red Mass was begun by Pope Innocent IV in 1243 for the Ecclesial Judicial Court asking the Invocation of the Holy Spirit as a source of wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude and strength for the coming term of court. St. Thomas More (pictured above) is the patron saint of Lawyers. All who work in the justice system are most welcome and encouraged to attend the event. Everyone else is very welcome as well. 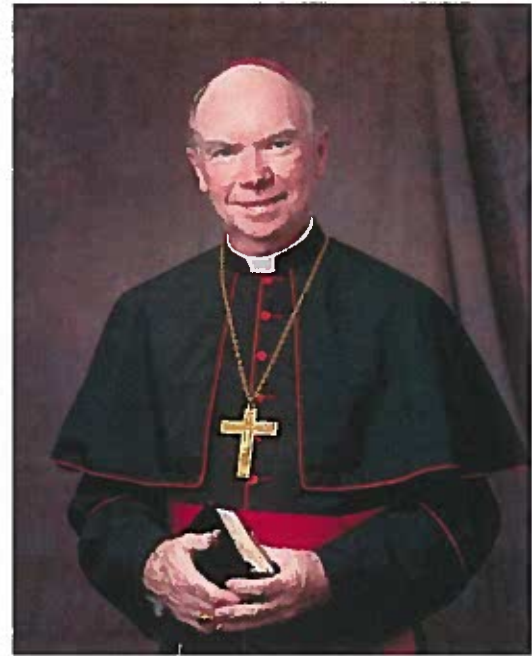

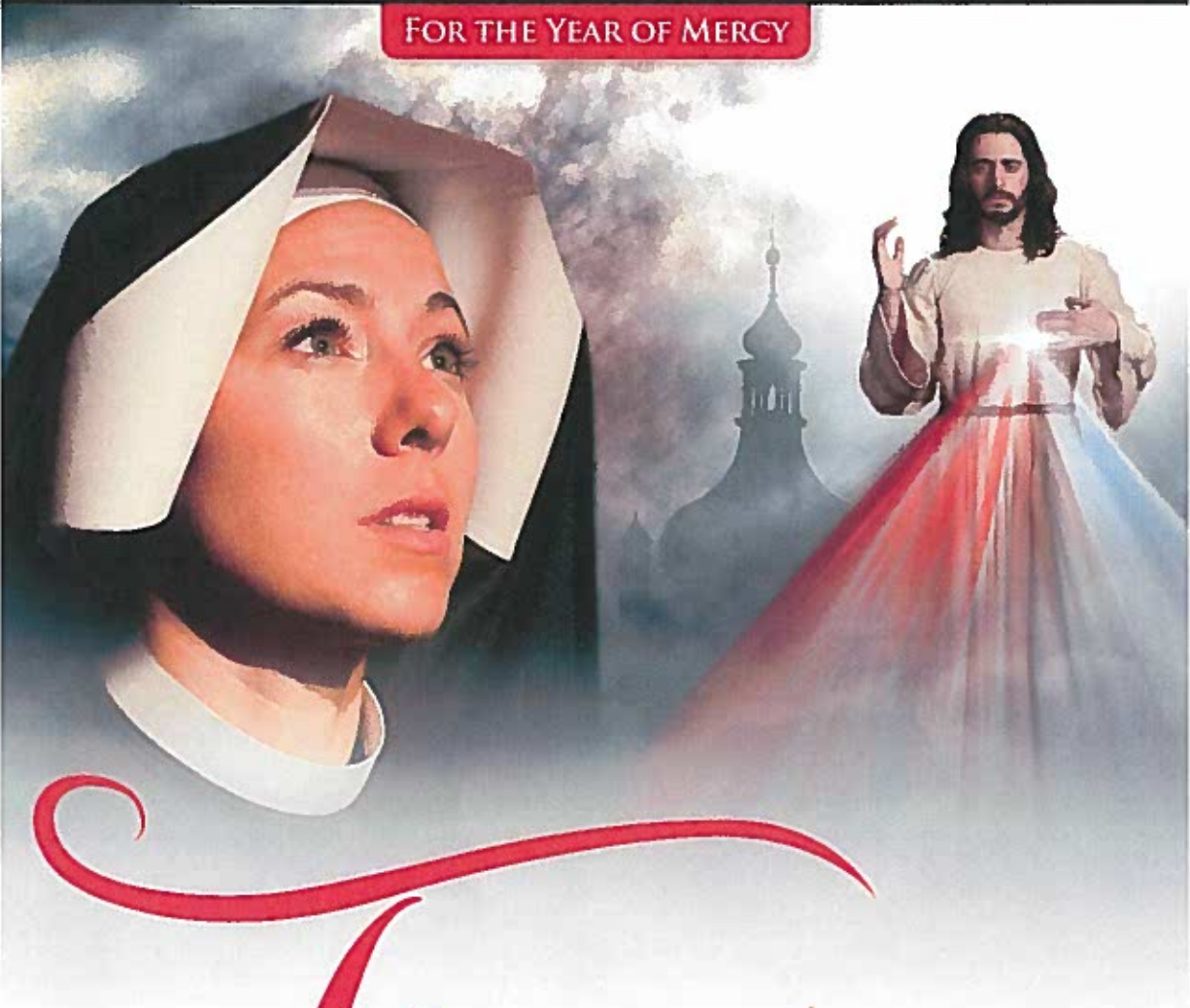
