**Lent begins soon** on Ash Wednesday, March 1. Masses Ash Wednesday with the distribution of Ashes will be at 7:45 am, 12:10 and 7 pm.

In His letter to prepare us for Lent the Holy Father says: Soon "we will embark in a new Lenten journey. Prayer, mercy and charity, conversion of heart, these are both our pillars and our solid ground, paving the road towards the Passion and the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

*"Where is your brother?"* (Gen 4:9) Pope Francis asks in his 2015 Lenten message. He makes a call for each of us to find "our brother" and unite "ourselves in prayer with the Church in heaven." Stand firm and hold fast to this call since "we (all) are tempted by indifference."

We are asked to search again for that "strong and steadfast heart, closed to the tempter but open to God. A heart which lets itself be pierced by the Spirit so as to bring love along the roads that lead to our brothers and sisters." "Let us not underestimate the power of so many voices united in prayer!" Pope Francis urges us in his message.





**ST. MARY'S MUSIC MINISTRY:** As of Feb. 13<sup>th</sup> forward, there will be a time when we will have fill-in organists, a cappella leadership and possibly no music until a new Music Director/organist is found. A search is under way. Ads have been placed on the Kingston branch Royal Canadian College of Organists (RCCO) website, on the National Royal Canadian College of Organists website, on the American Guild for Organists website and in papers like

the Catholic Register. The job description itself is on our website. The RCCO provide professional support to advise musicians and churches to assess levels of training and ability so that as good a fit for the musician and parish can be made as possible. We have already received a whopping **NINETEEN** applications; eleven Canadians and eight from United States. Most of them have Masters degrees in organ and conducting; some even have Doctorates in one or the other or both. A Selection Committee has been struck to discern among the interested musicians. It consists of: Deacon Blaine Barclay, Romeo Candido, Ellen Hawman, Ann Lyng, Allan Scott and myself. They have reviewed the *curriculum vitae* and we have had an initial meeting this



past Friday. Interviews will be set up with those that seem most desirable for our needs. Mr. David Cameron, one of the best musicians here in Kingston, has agreed to assess the applicants' skills as they audition on our organ. Please keep the finding of an organist very much in your prayers over the next couple of months.



We will say a special good-bye to Catherine Helferty, the present music director/organist, at the 10:30 am Mass on Sunday, February 12<sup>th</sup>. At that Mass we will present Catherine with a small hand painted icon of Our Lady for her to remember her time here at St. Mary's and we will present her with a lovely hand carved wooden statue of St. Cecilia (see the picture) the patroness of musicians. St. Cecilia is often depicted with an organ which she is in the one we got Catherine. Unfortunately, the statue has not arrived yet from Italy. We will see Catherine gets it as soon as it comes.
