

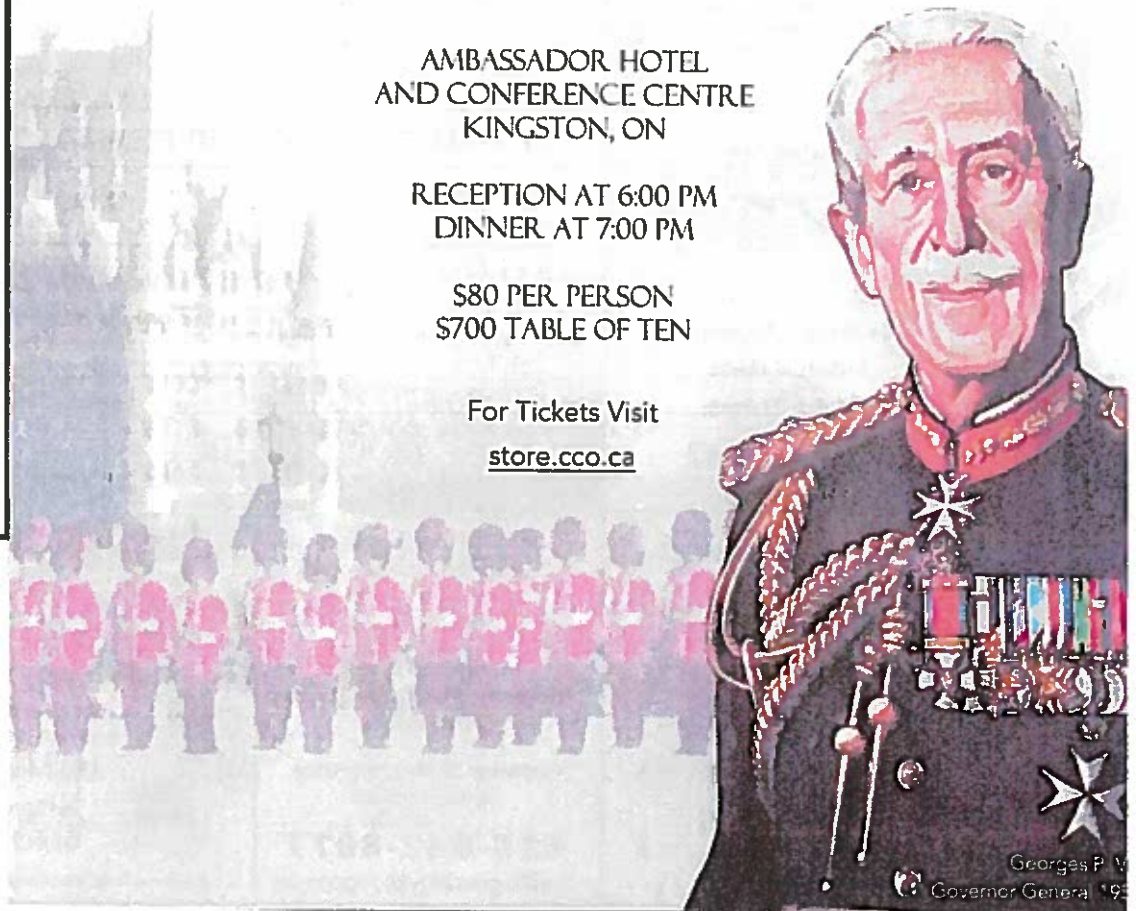

WHY WON'T THE GOVERNMENT OF ONTARIO PROTECT DOCTORS AND HEALTH CARE WORKERS?

Join the Call for Conscience: February 6 - March 31: The Ontario Government has introduced Bill 84, *Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID) Statute Law Amendment Act*, which, at present, does not provide conscience protection for doctors and health care providers who conscientiously object to taking part in Medically Assisted Dying. A "Call for Conscience" campaign has been initiated to encourage Ontarians to write to their local MPP's asking them to protect conscience rights – in particular, to support an amendment to Bill 84 that would provide conscience protection for doctors and health care providers and create a care coordination service which protects both patients and health care workers. The Issue

As of June 17, 2016, it is now legal for patients to request physician-assisted suicide in Canada. Almost every other province has created a process to provide MAID without compromising healthcare provider's consciences. Ontario's newly introduced legislation, Bill 84, does not include any conscience protections.

Despite limited conscience protection in federal legislation (Bill C-14) and freedom of conscience enshrined in the *Canadian Charter of Rights & Freedoms*, the CPSO has abandoned thousands of doctors who cannot provide referrals for medical assistance in dying. In fact, they are threatening to investigate these doctors and some even suggest they should move into cosmetic surgery or sports medicine or out of medicine entirely.

While health care workers respect the decision of patients, these doctors entered into medicine to save lives, not end them.

Ontarians shouldn't have to compromise their conscience.

In Canada, everyone has the right to their faith and their conscience. Our national coalition is focused on protecting Ontario doctors from the regulatory requirements from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario by advocating for conscience protection in upcoming provincial legislation (Bill 84).

With physician-assisted suicide now legal in Canada, healthcare practitioners and facilities in some provinces are in a compromised position.

Those who cannot support assisted suicide or euthanasia because of their conscience, faith, or commitment to the Hippocratic Oath could be forced to compromise their convictions. They shouldn't have to.

Catholics stand opposed to assisted suicide.

We need your help now to ensure Canadians' faith and conscience rights are protected in the province of Ontario.

LENT BEGINS THIS WEDNESDAY

ASH WEDNESDAY BEGINS LENT, THIS WEDNESDAY, MARCH 1, with the distribution of **THE BLESSED ASHES** at the **7:45 am, 12:10 (Archbishop O'Brien presiding) and 7 pm Masses.** In his letter to prepare us for Lent the Holy Father says: Soon “we will embark in a new Lenten journey. Prayer, mercy and charity, conversion of heart, these are both our pillars and our solid ground, paving the road towards the Passion and the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. “*Where is your brother?*”(Gen 4:9) Pope Francis asks in his 2015 Lenten message. He makes a call for each of us to find “our brother” and unite “ourselves in prayer with the Church in heaven.” Stand firm and hold fast to this call since “we (all) are tempted by indifference.”

We are asked to search again for that “strong and steadfast heart, closed to the tempter but open to God. A heart which lets itself be pierced by the Spirit so as to bring love along the roads that lead to our brothers and sisters.” “Let us not underestimate the power of so many voices united in prayer!” Pope Francis urges us in his message.



STATIONS OF THE CROSS: This beautiful meditation on our Saviour’s last hours is traditionally prayed on Fridays throughout the year and more often in Lent. Using various formats and various leaders we will pray it after every 12:10 pm Mass, Monday to Friday, and one half hour before the Saturday 5 pm & Sunday 10:30 am & 7 pm Masses. Please include this beautiful prayer as part of your Lenten preparation of your heart to celebrate, in a deeper way this year, the Great Solemnity of Our God’s Love for us in His Suffering, Death and Resurrection at Easter.

They are the blueprint or road map of the Christian life. Disciples of Jesus Christ strive to live the Beatitudes in their lives. They guide. They teach. They point. Beatitude comes from the Latin *beatus* meaning happiness. They not only bring a believer into a state of peace and happiness, but, if followed completely, will bring the believer right into the Kingdom of God after our journey on this earth is over.
