

A search is under way. Ads have been placed on the Kingston branch Royal Canadian College of Organists (RCCO) website, on the National Royal Canadian College of Organists website, on the American Guild for Organists website and in papers like the Catholic Register. The job description itself is on our website. The RCCO provide professional support to advise musicians and churches to assess levels of training and ability so that as good a fit for the musician and parish can be made as possible. We have already received twelve applications. Most of these are from the United States. Most of them have Masters degrees in organ and conducting; some even have Doctorates in one or the other or both. We will wait a few weeks for further Canadian applicants and then the selection committee will be struck to discern among the interested musicians. Mr. David Cameron, one of the best musicians here in Kingston, has agreed to assess the applicants' skills as they audition on our organ. Please keep the finding of an organist very much in your prayers over the next couple of months.




