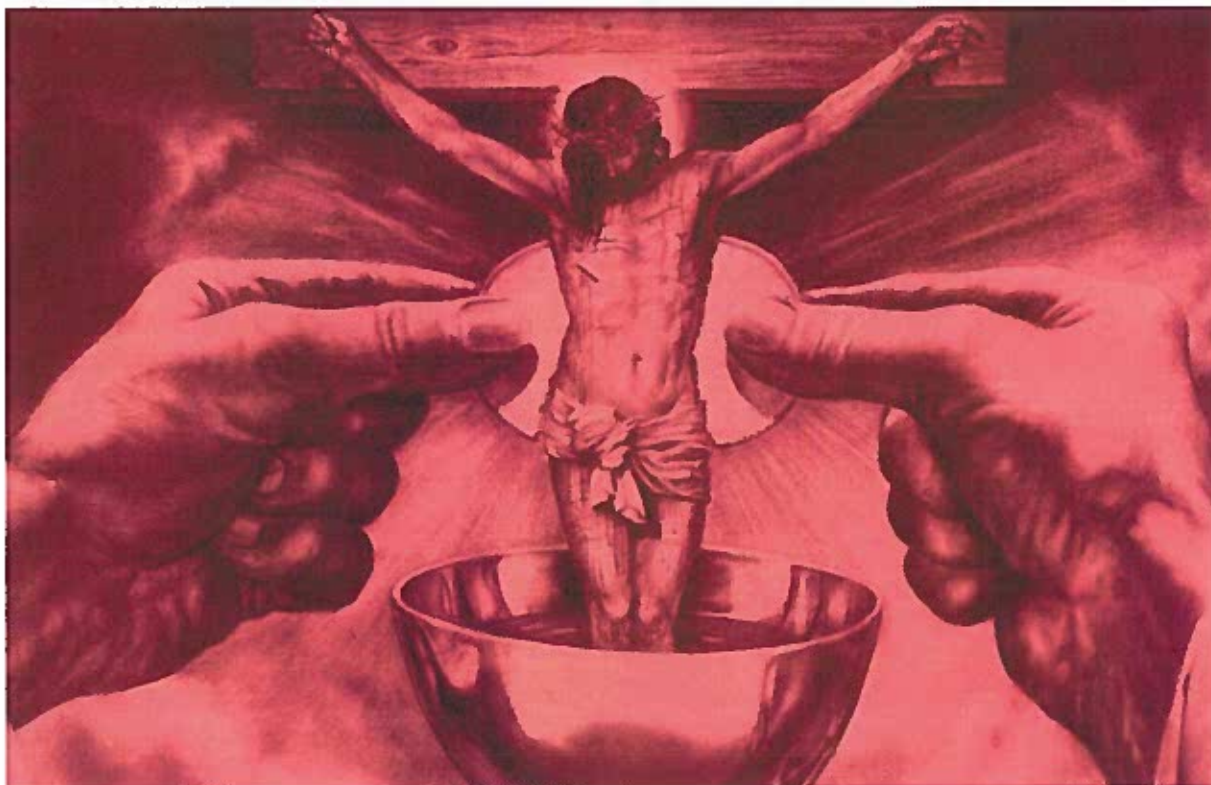

A TRULY CATHOLIC OBITUARY: I saw this obituary in the Whig Standard the week before last and was truly edified:

Robert (Bobby) Robertson "Peacefully at Briargate, Amherstview, on Saturday, June 3rd, 2017, fortified by the Sacraments of the Church and surrounded by the love of his family, in his 88th year....."

Fortified by the sacraments of the Church..... Beautiful! What a wonderful testimony to Bobby's faith and that of his family's and what a wonderful witness to anyone who reads it. It shows that this family saw the need for someone who is dying to receive the Sacrament of the Sick and Holy Communion before they died. His parish priest was able to give him all the sacraments. Holy Communion when someone is dying is called Viaticum: literally "with you on the way," meaning Holy Communion gives one the grace of not dying alone but that the person dies with Christ who promises us eternal life. Also the sacrament bestows forgiveness of sin, healing and peace.

This is a great opportunity to remind you that your priest or the priest on call at the hospital should be called to bring Holy Communion and the Sacrament of the Sick to anyone who is dying. If they are able to receive Holy Communion they will and anyone near death should be anointed. There is a priest on call at KGH 24 hours a day. Just tell the nurse that you would like the Catholic priest on call to come. Also, the phone of the rectory rings in my bedroom so you can get in touch with me at any time of the day or night to come if your loved one is dying. My main job here is to bring you the sacraments. A very important sacrament is the Sacrament of the Sick. Please don't deprive me of the grace of coming to your loved one's bedside as they are dying.

FROM ARCHBISHOP O'BRIEN: In response to the humanitarian crisis in South Sudan, Yemen, Somalia, and northeast Nigeria, an ecumenical appeal has been launched to provide assistance to the 20 million victims of the devastating famine.
