Are You or Someone You Know thinking of becoming a Catholic or interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith?

Consider joining The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). RCIA is an Initiation Process into the Catholic Faith for Adults who a) have never been baptized, b) are Christians baptized in another Faith Tradition seeking now to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church, and c) for Catholics who are baptised, but who have not received either their first Holy Communion and/or the Sacrament of Confirmation and who now wish to complete their Christian initiation.

RCIA is a process of formation and education into the life, worship and mission of disciples of Jesus Christ in the Catholic Church. We gather one evening a week from 7 to 9 pm beginning in September, continuing and including the great celebration of the Great Easter Vigil and the initiation and reception of candidates into the Catholic Faith, and concludes a few weeks later after a period of postbaptismal catechesis. Father Shawn and Deacon Blaine will head up the Formation Team this year. All those planning on taking the course must meet initially with either Father Shawn, fathershawnjhughes@gmail.com or Deacon Blaine at bbarclay31@me.com. Please contact one of us for an appointment.

PART III: A Continuation from The Discernment of Spirits: An Ignatian Guide for Everyday Living Workshops this past Spring

BE AWARE UNDERSTAND ACT

The first two sessions have discussed the 14 rules of St. Ignatius of Loyola discerning what is the difference between spiritual consolation and spiritual desolation and how God acts in each and how the enemy acts in each. The 14 rules also discuss what we are to do when we find ourselves in spiritual desolation.

These two sessions cover the relatively unknown further 8 rules of St. Ignatius of Loyola in discerning between two spiritual consolations. When an undertaking awakens spiritual joy within us, is this joy, this happy sense of closeness to God, always a sign that God is calling us to the undertaking? If it is not, how may we distinguish when such joy is a sign of God's call and when it is not? And if, in a particular situation, such joy is not an indication of God's promptings, how are we to understand it?

These two sessions will seek to grasp clearly what persons who strive to "rise from good to better" in the service of the Lord they love, and who along the way, face sensitive and critically important discernment regarding spiritual consolation. What do you do when there are two paths proposed to you that are both good. How do you discern which is the one for you to take.

If you did not happen to join us this past Spring for the first two sessions you would still profit from these two sessions.
