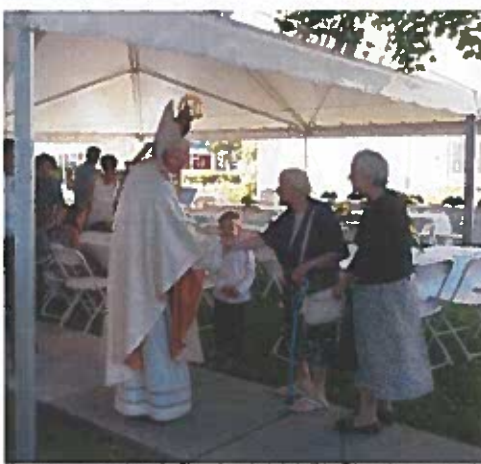

## ST MARY'S REFUGEE SPONSORSHIP: OUR SECOND FAMILY IS ARRIVING SOON!

It has been a long wait, but once again St Mary's refugee committee is preparing to welcome a new family to Canada.

Nineteen months ago, we began the sponsorship process for our second refugee family from Burundi. The mother, Seconde, had newly arrived in Canada after having escaped persecution in Burundi for her human rights work. However, since then, Seconde's young adult sons and husband have been living in a refugee camp in Rwanda, one of the sons having escaped Burundi by swimming the river that divides Burundi and Rwanda in the middle of the night. Her teenage daughters have been in hiding in Burundi in the home of a family friend.

Finally, this divided family will begin to reunite. We are expecting the arrival of Seconde's husband, Guy, and their sons, Arnaud, Faby, Amy-Doux, and Rodrigue, in the coming months. The required government paperwork has not yet been finalized for their daughters and nephew.

Seconde has already found a house and has asked for our help with moving in. Due to your previous enormous generosity, we already have a large collection of household goods and furniture in storage

in our parish centre. We invite everyone interested in helping to please join us on move-in day! We will need many hands – furniture haulers, kitchen organizers, unpackers, and fixer-uppers.

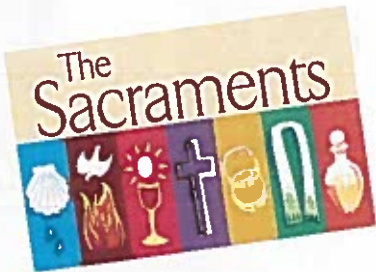
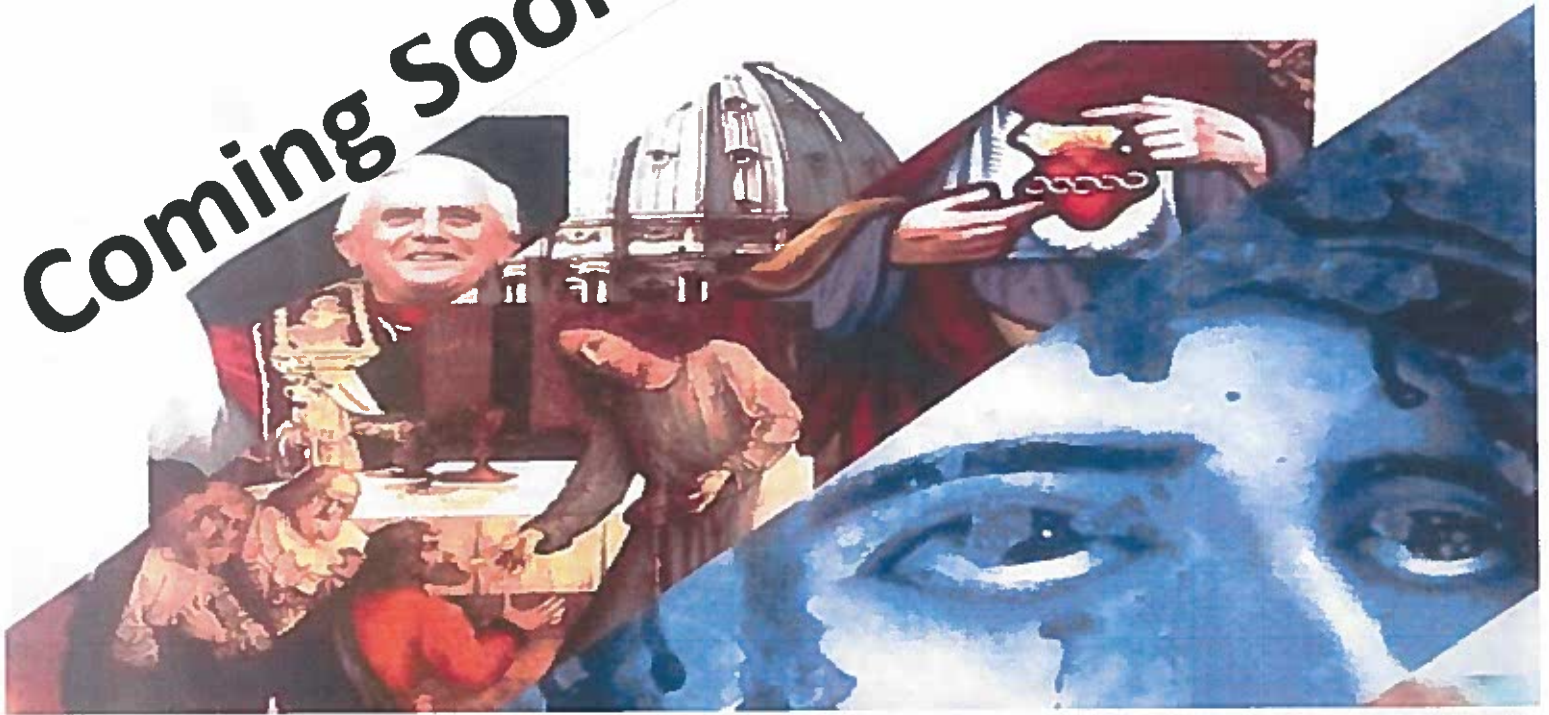

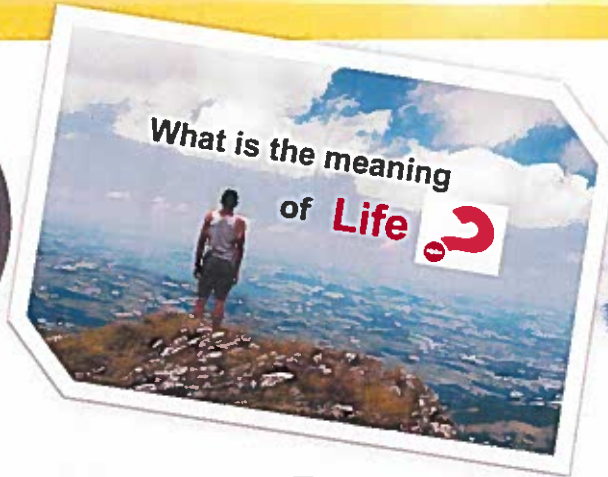
