



Are You or Someone You Know thinking of becoming a Catholic or interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith?

Consider joining The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). RCIA is an Initiation Process into the Catholic Faith for Adults who a) have never been baptized, b) are Christians baptized in another Faith Tradition seeking now to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church, and c) for Catholics who are baptised, but who have not received either their first Holy Communion and/or the Sacrament of Confirmation and who now wish to complete their Christian initiation.

RCIA is a process of formation and education into the life, worship and mission of disciples of Jesus Christ in the Catholic Church. We will gather on Tuesday evenings from 7 pm to 9 pm beginning in September, continuing and including the great celebration of the Great Easter Vigil and the initiation and reception of candidates into the Catholic Faith, and concludes a few weeks later after a period of postbaptismal catechesis. Father Shawn and Deacon Blaine will head up the Formation Team this year. 

A Little History on our Father Francesco:

Father Francesco Msofu (rhymes with tofu M-so-foo) began his time as the Associate Pastor here at St. Mary's Cathedral this past Tuesday, August 1, 2017. Father Francesco was born on June 22, 1970, in Ukami, Tanzania. He is the first born of James Msofu and Jamlaya Kaguo who are both now deceased. His other siblings are Yusta Msofu, who is also deceased (she left one child – Yusto Kanyika) and his younger brother Jauson Msofu who is married to Seduma. They have three children. Fr. Francesco was baptized when he was 17 years old.

After his baptism and confirmation, he joined St. Cafasso minor seminary at

Tosamaganga preparatory seminary for one year and then he joined St. Kizito minor seminary at Mafinga for six years. After completing the minor seminary, he was assigned as a formator at Tosamaganga preparatory seminary for one year, as a preparation for joining the major seminary, St. Augustine Major Seminary, Peramiho, Tanzania. After doing his Philosophy and Theology at St. Augustine seminary, before his ordination to a diaconate, he

stayed at Ilole Parish for one year for pastoral experience. In December 28, 2001, the Feast of the Holy Innocents, he was ordained a deacon and in July 3, 2002, the Feast day of St. Thomas the Apostle, he was ordained a priest for the diocese of Iringa, Tanzania. After his ordination he served for few months as an Assistant Pastor at Ulete Parish and in 2003 he was appointed as the pastor of Wasa Parish

(www.mwendo.org). From 2010 - 2013 he was in Lugano, Switzerland and then in Venice, Italy to study Canon Law and Comparative Religious Studies. While he was in Lugano, he served as an Administrator of the parish at Santa Maria Assunta, Villa Luganese. From 2010, he came to St. Paul University in Ottawa for further studies in Canon Law. From September 2015, he served as a chaplain at Providence Manor and from August 1, 2017 he has been appointed as Associate Pastor at St. Mary's Cathedral. Father Francesco will be continuing to celebrate one of the Masses each day and will be part of the homily team as well as being

available for spiritual counselling, confessions and assisting with the formation of couples to be married and with families bringing their children forth for baptism. He can be reached at 613-546-5521 ext. 6, or francescomsofu@gmail.com


