Responsibilities: make coffee for approx.. 70 persons, set the table with cups/cutlery, turn on the dishwasher after the meal, ensure washrooms are stocked, both at the beginning and ending of the meal. Assist the teams to bring in groceries. After the meal, sweep and mop the floors, pay attention to the kitchen area, and put the garbage out. Ensure all the lights are out and the doors are locked behind you. Monitor supplies and let Parish office know when refills are needed. In the winter ensure that the entrances are clean of snow and ice to prevent falls, St. John's will provide salt and shovels.
