The First two days of the Hotel Dieu/St. Mary's Coat Drive

The St. Mary's/HDH Coat Drive opened its doors on Mon. Nov. 12 to a record number of patrons! During the first 2 days of the Winter Coat Distribution, a total of 187 people, 54 men and 133 women, came in search of warm winter clothing. The increase in the number of women attending the Coat Drive from previous years reflects the results of the latest Point in Time count of Kingston's homeless population which shows that an alarmingly high number experiencing homelessness are women – 55%, twice the national average. In

addition to the 130 winter coats handed out during the first 2 days, 193 accessories including mitts, socks, toques, boots, blankets and sweaters were also distributed. More coats are desperately needed especially the larger sizes. 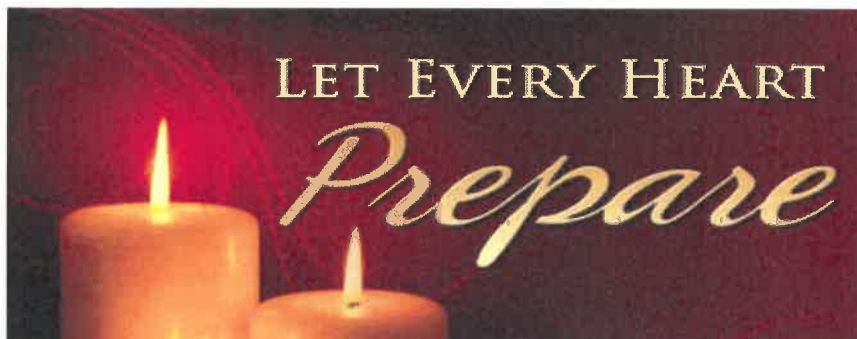
