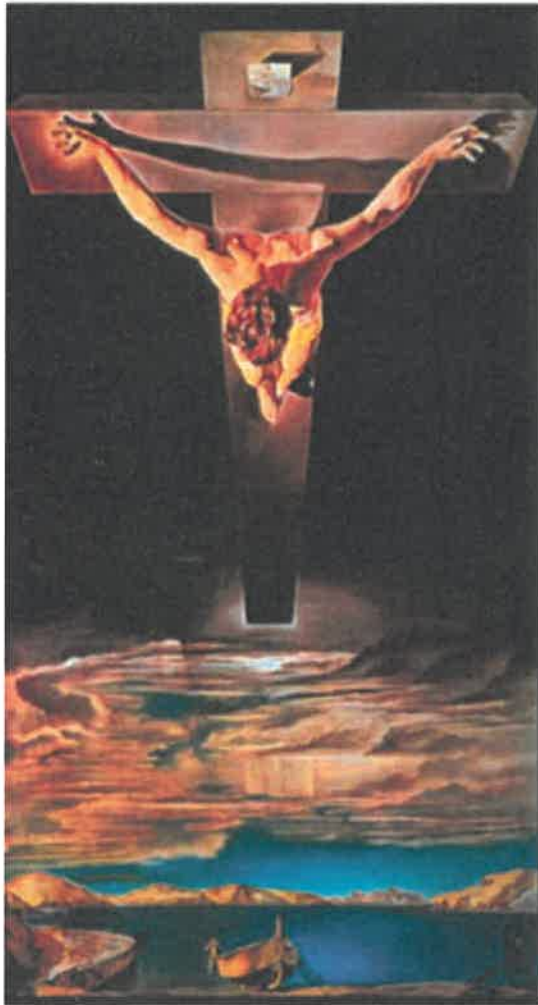

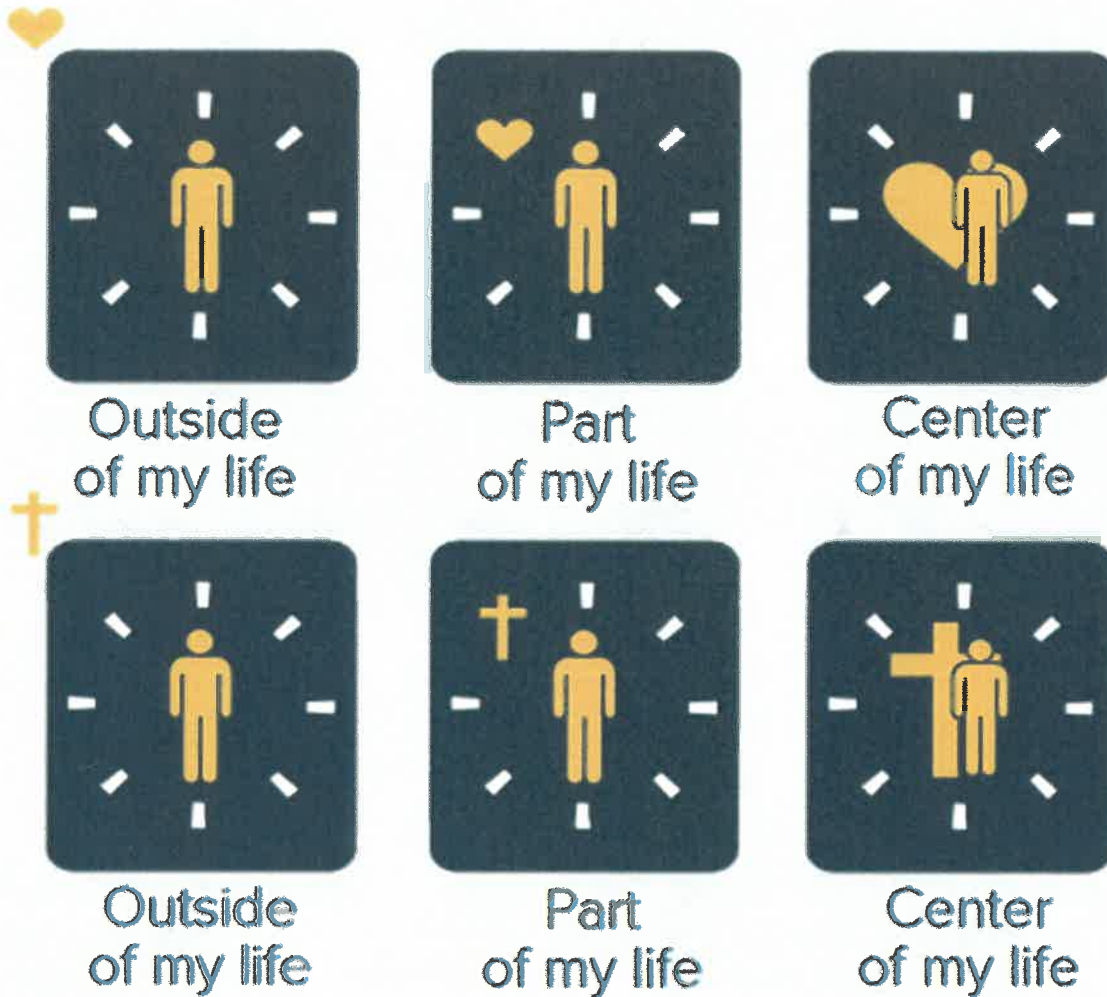

“The top 3 images represent levels of commitment in 3 kinds of human relationship. The first image represents someone who is single without a romantic relationship in their life. The second image represents someone who is dating. This relationship is a part of their life, but commitment is limited. The third image represents someone who is married; there is an intimate relationship and permanent mutual commitment. LET’S COMPARE THIS TO OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD. The bottom 3 images represent levels of commitment in a relationship with God. The first image represents someone who does not have a relationship with Jesus. Jesus is outside of their life as far as they are concerned. The 2nd image represents someone who acknowledges Jesus as part of their life, but has not completely committed to him. Jesus is just one aspect of their life among many others. The 3rd image represents a Christ-centred relationship. This relationship is primary and central, influencing all decisions and every aspect of their life.”

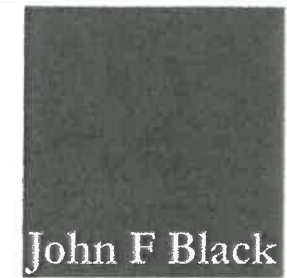
