**Are You or Someone You Know thinking of becoming a Catholic or interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith?**

Consider joining The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA). RCIA is an Initiation Process into the Catholic Faith for Adults who a) have never been baptized, or b) are Christians baptized in another Faith Tradition seeking now to be received into full communion with the Catholic Church, or c) for Catholics who are baptised, but who have not received either their first Holy Communion and/or the Sacrament of Confirmation and who now wish to complete their Christian initiation.

RCIA is a process of formation and education into the life, worship and mission of disciples of Jesus Christ in the Catholic Church. We gather on Tuesdays from 7 to 9 pm beginning in September, continuing and including the great celebration of the Great Easter Vigil and the initiation and reception of candidates into the Catholic Faith, and concludes a few weeks later after a period of postbaptismal catechesis. Father Shawn and Deacon Blaine will head up the Formation Team this year. Please contact one of us for an appointment.
