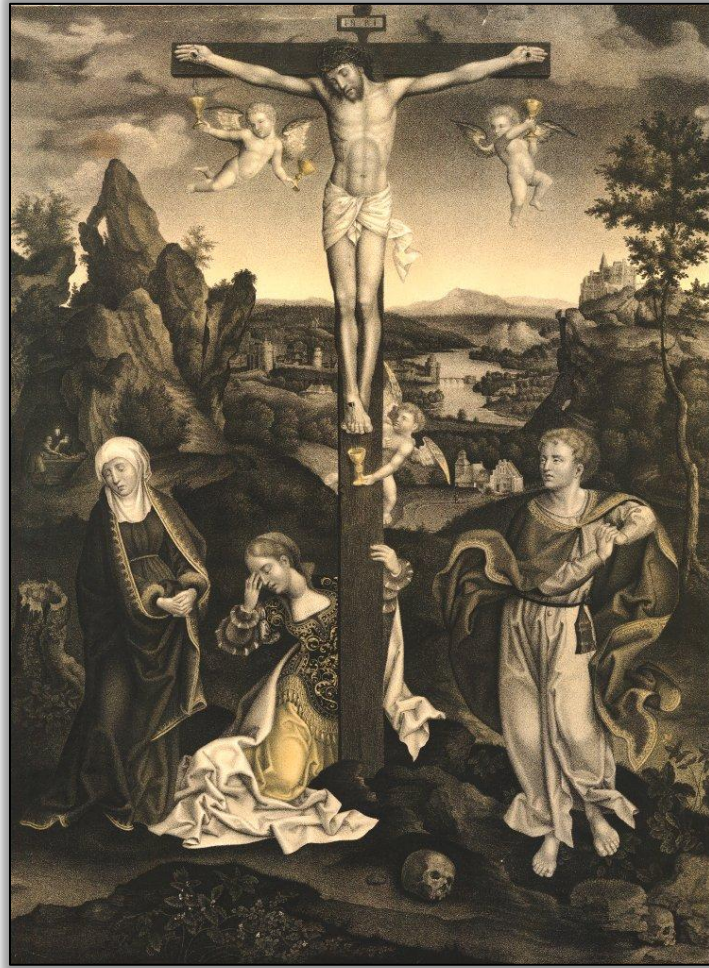


# The Celebration of the Passion of the Lord

Give us this day our daily bread;  
and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us;  
and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

**CELEBRANT:** Deliver us, Lord, we pray, from every evil, graciously grant peace in our days,  
that, by the help of your mercy, we may always be free from sin  
and safe from all distress, as we await the blessed hope  
and the coming of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

**ALL:** For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours, now and forever.

**CELEBRANT:** Behold the Lamb of God; behold him who takes away the sins of the world.  
Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.

**ALL:** Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof,  
but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.
