



EASTER PROCLAMATION (Exultet)

The Easter Proclamation is a song of praise unique and unequalled in liturgical hymnody.

The first section contains a poetic fanfare of sorts with three exclamations,
each beginning with, "Rejoice" (the word "Exsultet" in Latin).

Then follows the body of the hymn, wherein the parallels between
the Old Testament Passover and the joyful Resurrection of Christ are extolled.

The conclusion is a prayer that the Almighty Father accept the offering of the Paschal Candle.

and safe from all distress, as we await the blessed hope





but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.


DISTRIBUTION OF HOLY COMMUNION




