have mercy on us and on the whole world.

*Concluding Doxology after five decades (said 3 times):*

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One,  
have mercy on us and on the whole world.

*Leader:* E - ter - nal Fa - ther, I of - fer You the Bo - dy and Blood,  
Soul and Di - vi - ni - ty of Your dear - ly be - lov - ed Son,  
Our Lord, Je - sus Christ,  
*All:* in a - tone - ment for our sins, and those of the whole world.

Decades 1, 3 & 5

*Leader:* For the sake of His sor - row - ful pas - sion,  
*All:* Have mer - cy on us and on the whole world.

Decades 2 & 4

*Leader:* For the sake of His sor - row - ful pas - sion,  
*All:* Have mer - cy on us and on the whole world.

After 5 decades, sing 3 times:

*All:* Ho - ly God, Ho - ly Might - y One, Ho - ly Im - mor - tal One,  
Have mer - cy on us, and on the whole world. and on the whole world.
