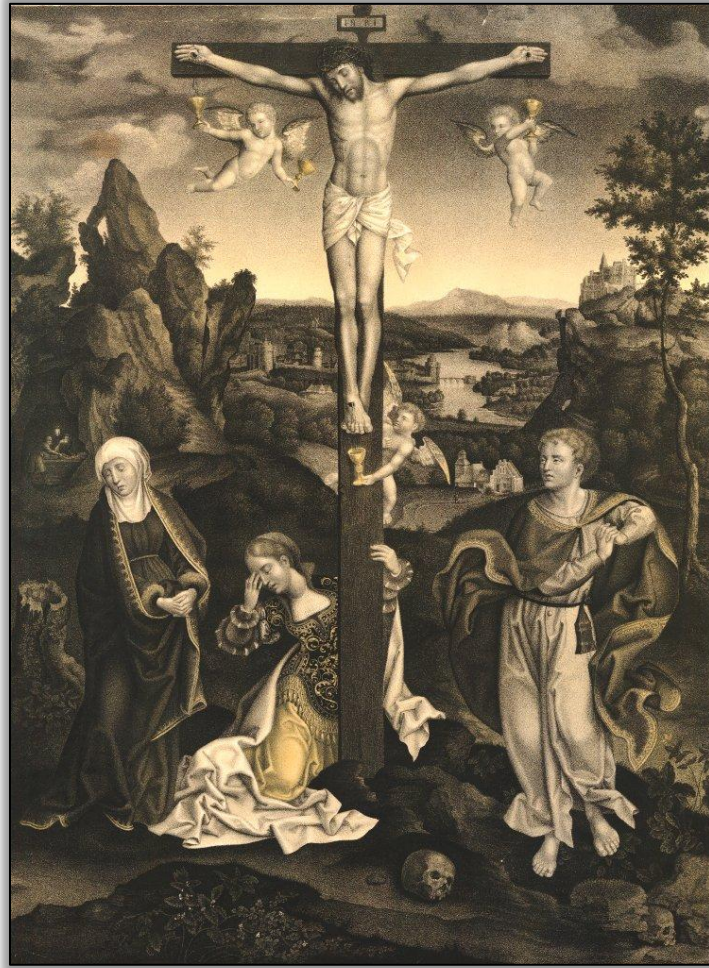


# The Celebration of the Passion of the Lord

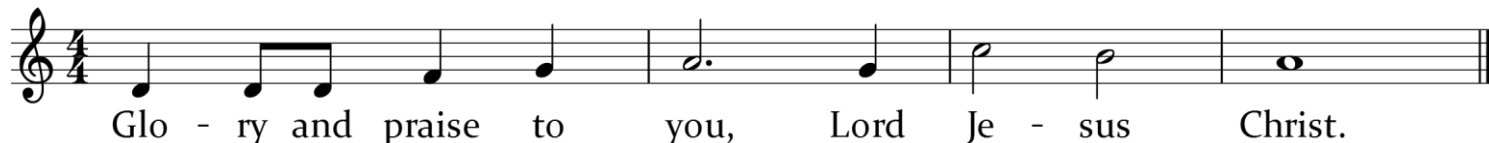

## THE LORD'S PRAYER

ALL: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name;  
thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread;  
and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us;  
and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

CELEBRANT: Deliver us, Lord, we pray, from every evil...  
as we await the blessed hope and the coming of our Saviour, Jesus Christ.

ALL: For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours, now and forever.

*Please kneel.*

CELEBRANT: Behold the Lamb of God; behold him who takes away the sins of the world.  
Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.

ALL: Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof,  
but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.

## DISTRIBUTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

*Those who are Catholic and receiving Holy Communion this afternoon
