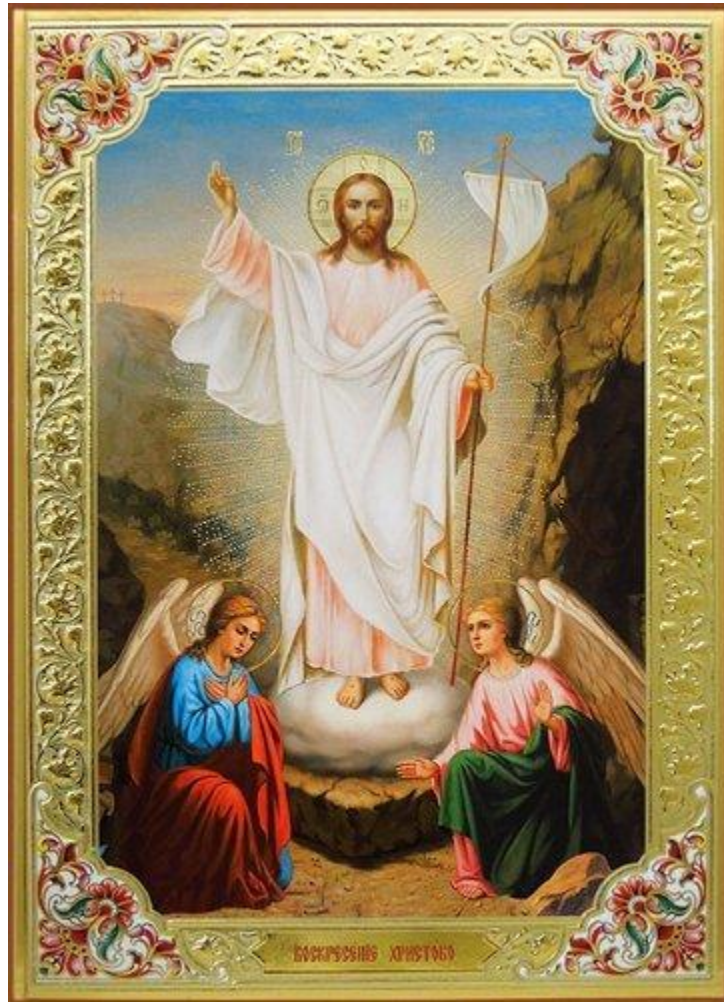

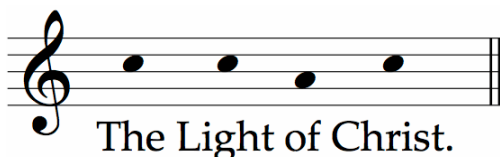

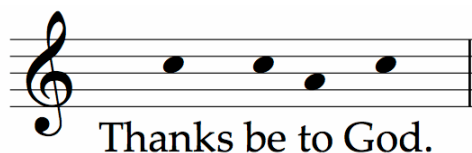
PROCESSION
