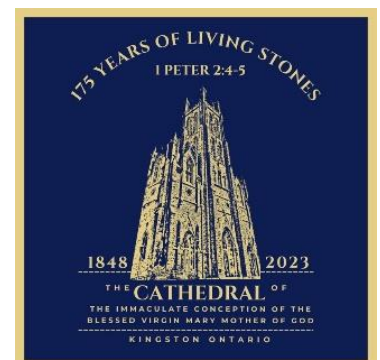
## 175 Years of Living Stones

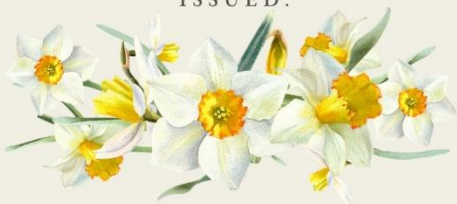

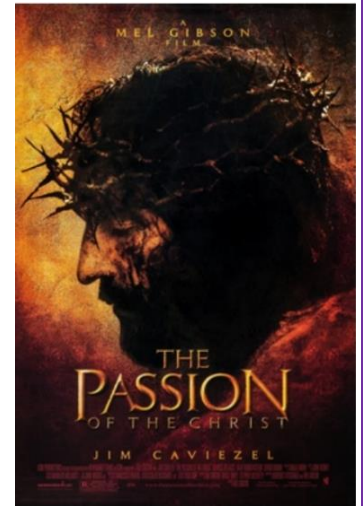
## LOOKING AHEAD
