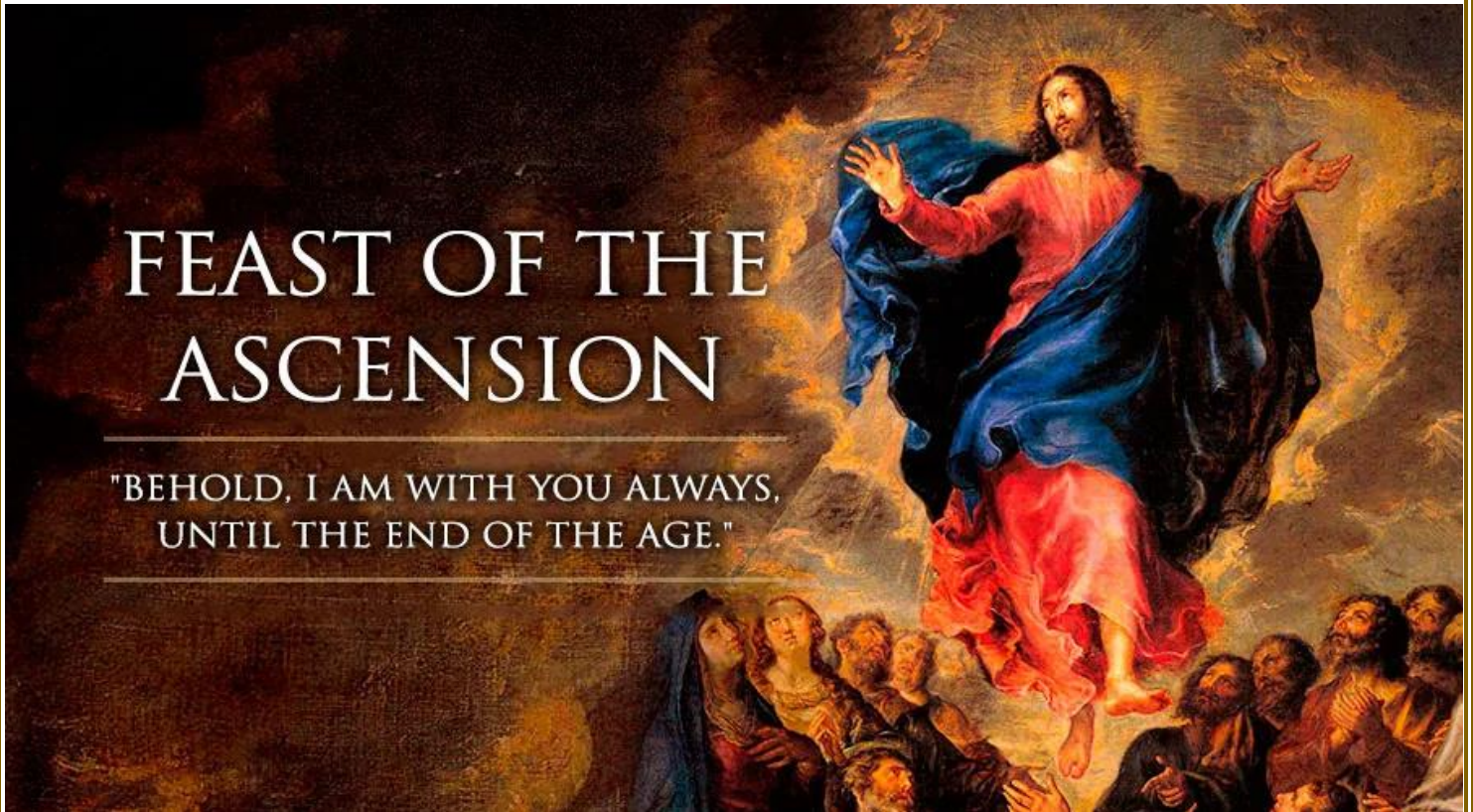

## 175 Years of Living Stones

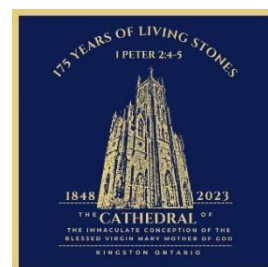

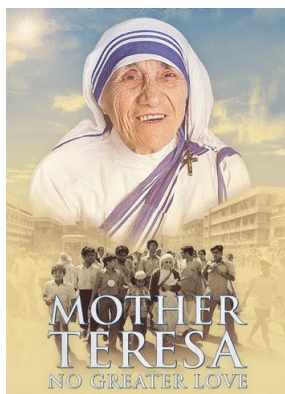


## Seniors' Lunch "Summer Picnic"
