



The Son of a Long-Time Parishioner at Holy Family is in Urgent Need of a Living Liver Transplant


He has four young children and requires a Donor with type O blood. The liver is an amazing organ that quickly rejuvenates for a living donor.




Seniors' Lunch "Summer Picnic"
