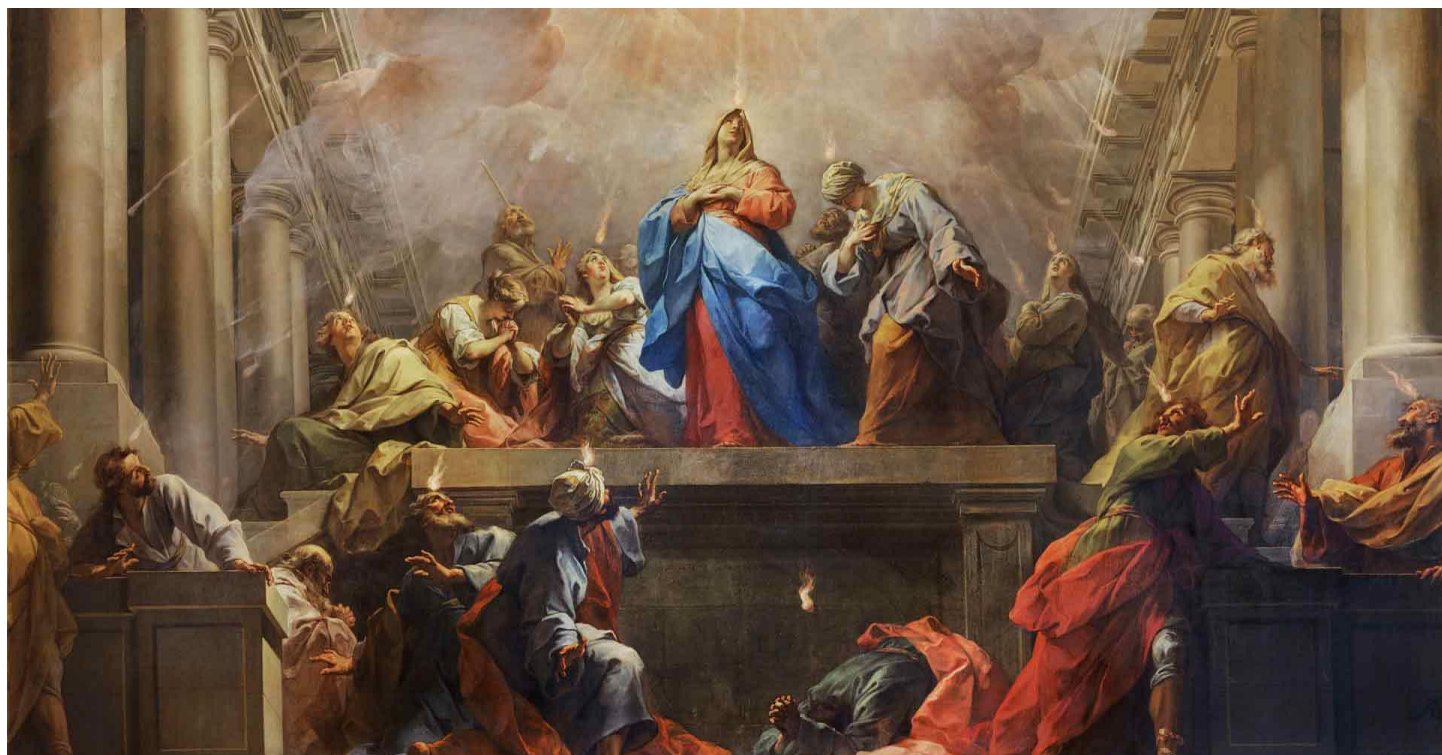

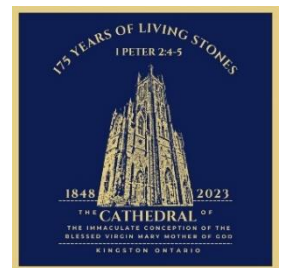

Please keep Susan and her family in your prayers this week.

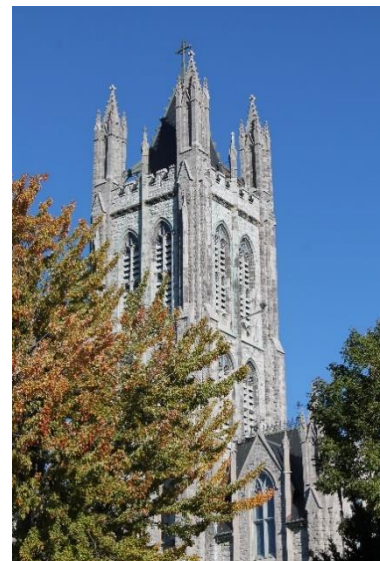

## Refugee Family

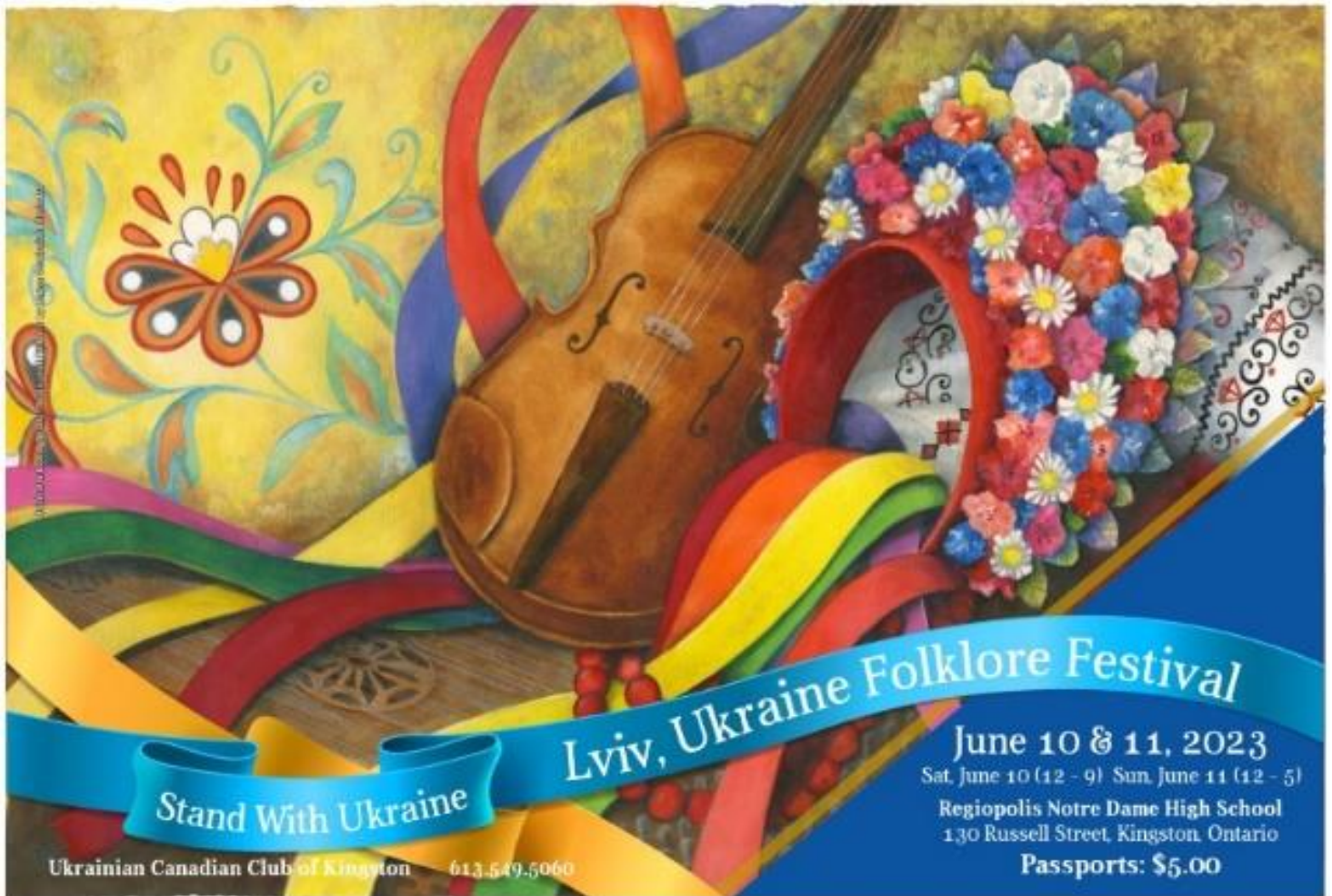
