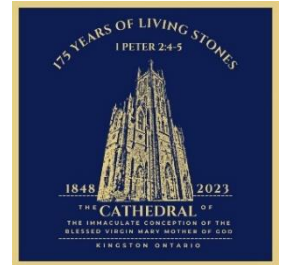

Please keep Anne in your prayers this week.

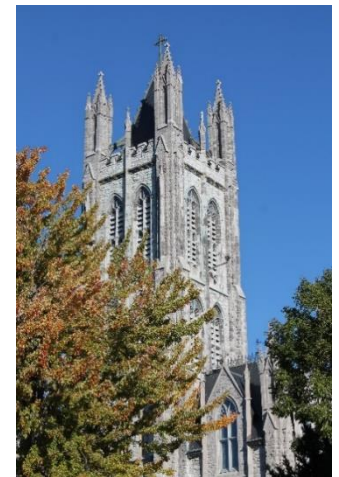
