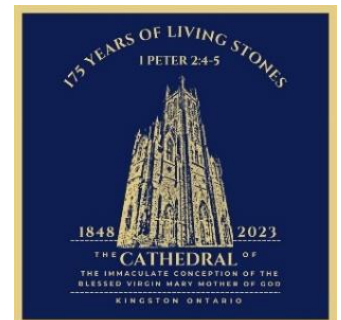

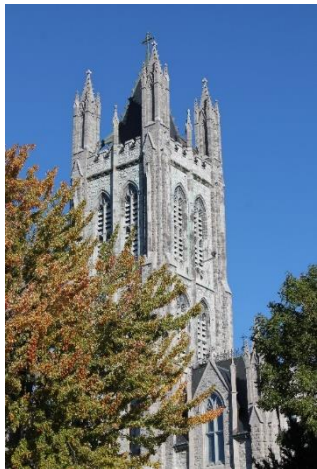
Pilgrimage to St. Ann's Shrine in Cormac, ON
