

**May 4<sup>th</sup>, 10:30 am, here at the Cathedral the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass will be offered to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the closing of the St. Joseph School of Nursing here in Kingston at Hotel Dieu in 1974 A.D.**



The Religious Hospitallers of St. Joseph (aka the Hotel Dieu Sisters) came to Kingston in 1847 A.D. just as the typhoid epidemic struck. Much heroic nursing service has taken place on the grounds of Hotel Dieu since that time. The St. Joseph Nursing School was founded in 1912 A.D. and closed 1974 A.D. The 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of their final class is this year and this special Mass will be held to commemorate it. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass will be offered in great gratitude to God for all the Sisters and all the lay nurses whose faith, regard for the dignity of human life, compassionate healing service met all those who had the occasion to be within the walls of Hotel Dieu since the sisters arrival in 1847 A.D. and especially the nurses formed in the St. Joseph School of Nursing and throughout their nursing careers. Please feel free to join us here at the cathedral for this Holy Mass of Gratitude.

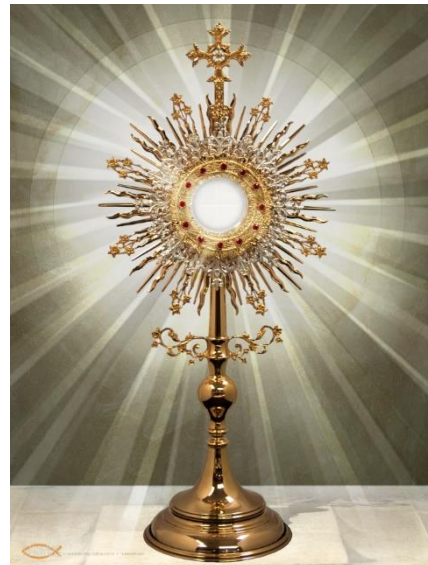

### **ADORERS, PLEASE MAKE A COMMITMENT!**

It is wonderful to see so many of you are spending time in St. James' Chapel. The great vibrancy of our parish is directly related to the grace pouring forth from the Lord in Adoration of Him in the Blessed Sacrament. I am rarely in St. James Chapel that there are not four, five or six others there. Thank you to the one person who has committed themselves to that hour so that the chapel can be open for you. However, even though all the hours are covered most of them have only one person committed to being there. That saves the Adoration Coordinator for having to scramble to get a substitute for you. Your hourly commitment shows that you are not only worshipping Our Lord God in the Blessed Sacrament but that you are caring for your brothers and sisters in the parish.
