## Priest's Retreat

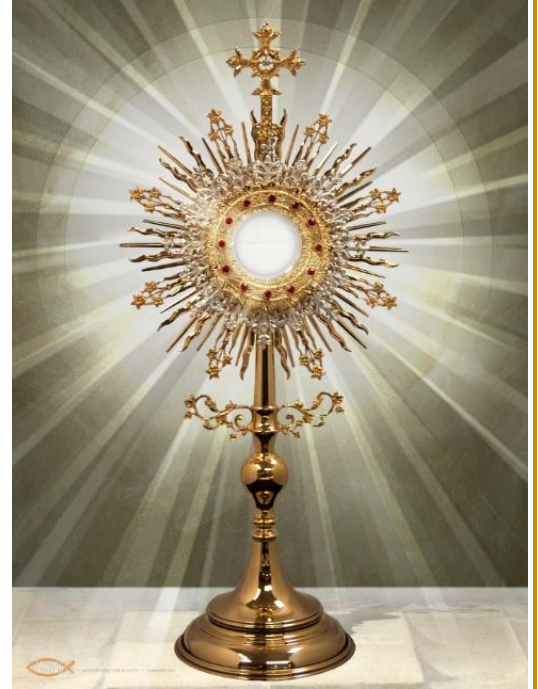
The Priests of the Archdiocese will be on retreat from Monday evening May 20<sup>th</sup> to Friday, May 24<sup>th</sup>. There will be no daily Masses here at the Cathedral from Tuesday to Friday of that week. There will be no confessions in the cathedral. The daily Eucharistic Adoration schedule will be the same beginning at 9 am to 9 pm, Tuesday to Friday. There will be daily Mass at St. John the Apostle at 8 am Tuesday to Friday.

## CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION: June 2<sup>nd</sup> after the 10:30 am Mass

Please plan on joining in for what hopefully will become an annual event. It is customary in many Catholic countries to have a procession of the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. We will take the Sacramental Lord in the monstrance and process around the outside of the cathedral, then pause for a moment of adoration on the steps of the cathedral and then process back into the cathedral for Benediction. It will all take about 20 minutes after Mass. Please join us as we publicly profess our Faith in the Real Presence of our Sacramental Lord in the Eucharist, Body, Mind, Soul and Divinity.

# ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT IN ST. JAMES' CHAPEL ADORERS, PLEASE MAKE A COMMITMENT!

It is wonderful to see so many of you are spending time in St. James' Chapel. The great vibrancy of our parish is directly related to the grace pouring forth from the Lord in Adoration of Him in the Blessed Sacrament. I am rarely in St. James Chapel that there are not four, five or six others there. Thank you to the one person who has committed themselves to that hour so that the chapel can be open for you. However, even though all the hours are covered most of them have only one person committed to being there. I am asking those of you who come often to the chapel, but who have not committed to one hour a week, would you please make a commitment to at least one hour. If there are two people for a given hour then when one of you is not able to be there you can then speak to your adoration partner and ensure they will be there so that one committed person is there for each hour. That saves the Adoration Coordinator for having to scramble to get a substitute for you. Your hourly commitment shows that you are not only worshipping Our Lord God in the Blessed Sacrament but that you are caring for your brothers and sisters in the parish. ## **Novena to the Holy Spirit**

Pentecost is Sunday, May 19<sup>th</sup>. The Novena will begin this upcoming Friday, May 10<sup>th</sup>.

To celebrate Pentecost, the descent of the Holy Spirit on the Church, you are invited to pray the Holy Spirit Novena! It is a powerful and moving novena that is meant to help us open up to the third person of the Holy Trinity. Even though we pray this novena as a preparation for the feast of Pentecost, you can also pray a novena to the Holy Spirit any time that you want. So, let us pray with great confidence and trust in our God who is all Good and Loving.

The Pentecost novena is the prototype of all novenas. It commemorates the nine days between the Ascension of Our Lord and the descent of the Holy Spirit on the first Pentecost Sunday. During this time Our Lady and the twelve Apostles prayed in the upper room for the coming of the Paraclete. The disciples waited in unity and prayer for the Holy Spirit for nine days after Jesus' ascension to heaven. Jesus asked them to pray constantly in the upper room until the descent of the Holy Spirit. "They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers." – Acts 1:14.
