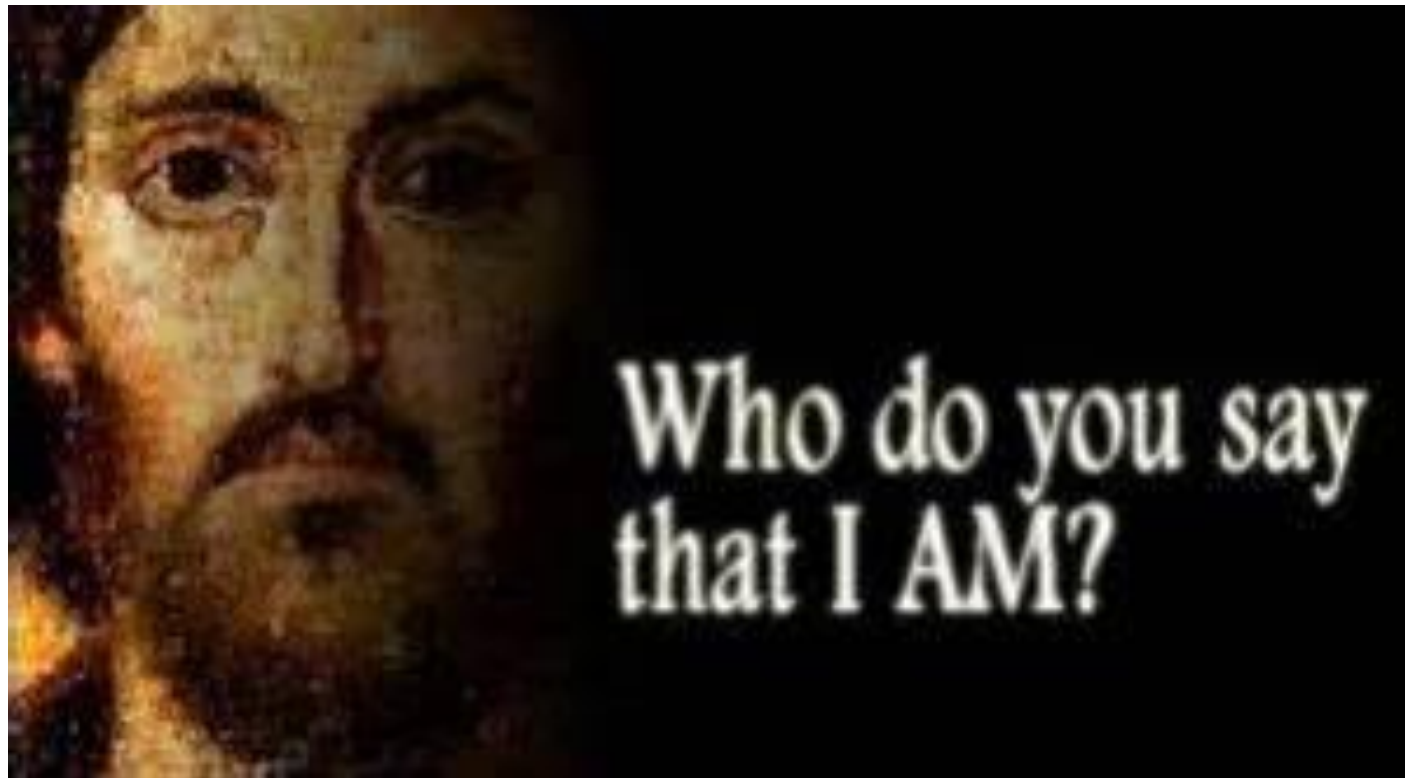

**Friday, October 4, 7:30 pm here in the Cathedral.**

Join St. Mary's Cathedral Taizé Schola under the direction of Domenico Sanfilippo. Taizé Prayer is an evening of sung contemplative prayer. It is a simple, meditative form of worship, calling us to dwell deeply on Christ's presence around and within us. Chanted

songs (like "Jesus, Remember Me"), prayerful silence, and short readings guide the focus of the prayer in a candle-lit environment. This evening of **Taizé Prayer** will approximately one hour from 7:30 pm to 8:30 pm and will be followed by a time of fellowship in the vestibule. ## SCAFFOLDING

You will notice that scaffolding has gone up over the ramp and the adjacent sidewalk. This is a protective measure requested by the Archdiocesan Cathedral Property Committee. After examining the drone images of the upper tower, it was decided that there was a potential for loose mortar/stone to possibly fall. The scaffolding will prevent potential injury. It will remain in place until the Spring or Summer when the repair work on the tower will be done.
