For next week at least, beginning Tuesday, the 12:10 pm Mass will be in the Chapel while the scaffolding goes up.

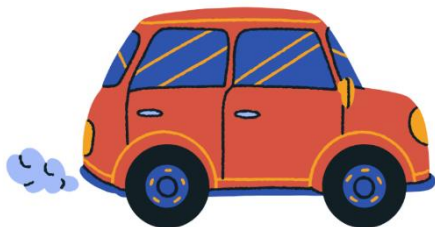
A priest will be in the confessional at 11:30 pm as usual. Enter the cathedral from the rectory courtyard side.

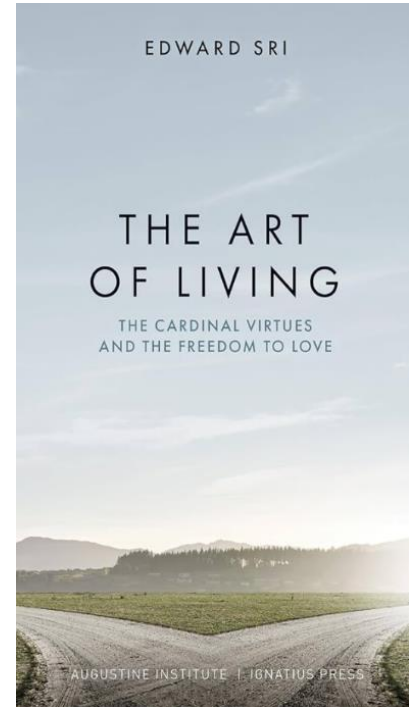

## Looking Ahead

Lent begins in just two weeks on Ash Wednesday, March 5<sup>th</sup>. Easter Sunday is April 20<sup>th</sup>. Easter is almost as late as it possibly can be. Remember the date of Easter is calculated by the lunar calendar. The date of Easter is the first Sunday after the first full moon after the Spring Equinox. The full moon in March will be the 14<sup>th</sup>. The Spring Equinox is March 21<sup>st</sup>. So, the first full moon after the Spring Equinox is the April full moon which is April 13<sup>th</sup>. The next Sunday is April 20<sup>th</sup> which is therefore Easter Sunday. Holy Mass will be celebrated at 7:45 am, 12:10 pm & 7 pm on Ash Wednesday.
