Looking Ahead

Lent begins in just two weeks on Ash Wednesday, March 5th. Easter Sunday is April 20th. Easter is almost as late as it possibly can be. Remember the date of Easter is calculated by the lunar calendar. The date of Easter is the first Sunday after the first full moon after the Spring Equinox. The full moon in March will be the 14th. The Spring Equinox is March 21st. So, the first full moon after the Spring Equinox is the April full moon which is April 13th. The next Sunday is April 20th which is therefore Easter Sunday. Holy Mass will be celebrated at 7:45 am, 12:10 pm & 7 pm on Ash Wednesday.
