CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

This Sunday we will celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi (The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ). It is a feast day in the Catholic Church that celebrates the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. It is a liturgical solemnity observed on the Thursday following the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, and in the Catholic Church in Canada is transferred to the following Sunday. The feast is a time to honour and give thanks for the gift of the Eucharist, which is the source and summit, the central dimension of our Faith.



It is traditional, as we did last year, to have a procession of the Blessed Sacrament after Holy Mass on this solemnity. We will process behind the Blessed Sacrament out the central doors of the cathedral, turn left and proceed north on Clergy Street, turn left and proceed west on Brock Street, and then turn left into the rectory courtyard and return to the central doors of the Cathedral. We will have a brief moment of silent adoration on the steps of the cathedral and then we will process back up the central aisle and conclude with Benediction and Reposition of the Blessed Sacrament. It will all take about 20 minutes after Mass. Please join us as we publicly profess our Faith in the Real Presence of our Sacramental Lord in the Eucharist, Body, Mind, Soul and Divinity.

85th Annual Pilgrimage to the Shrine of St. Ann in Cormac and Diocesan Celebration of the Jubilee Year of Hope
