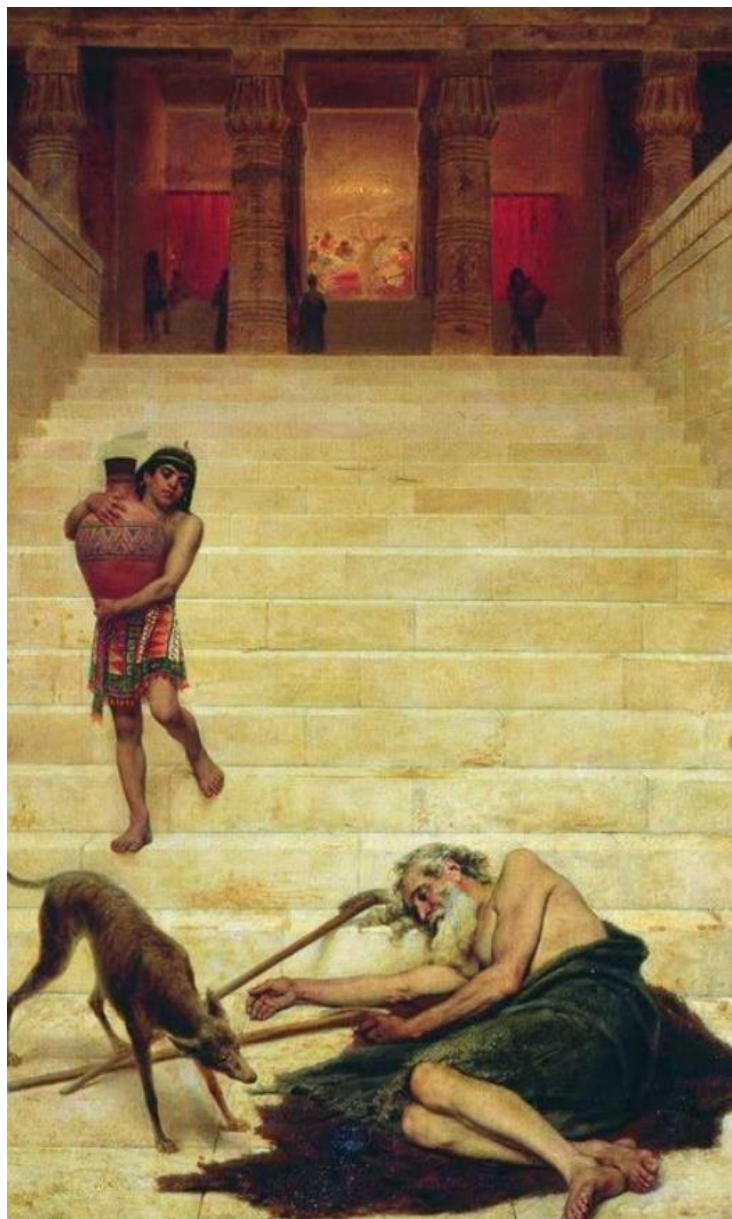

SEED SAVING INITIATIVE

When Carol and Robert Mouk retired from their market garden farm in 1999 they were looking for someone to hand over their collection of 650 heirloom seeds. The Sisters of Providence took up the call and the Mouk's operated the Heirloom Seed Sanctuary at their Motherhouse for the next ten years until their retirement in 2009.

Robert and Carol will have some photos and records of this seed saving initiative and they will be available to answer questions about the history of the seed sanctuary and about seed saving in general.
